Listed below are the 2022 poverty guidelines published in the Federal Register on January 21, 2022 by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Figures refer to monthly income.

<u>Poverty Level</u>	<u>Single Person</u>	<u>Couple</u>
<i>100% poverty</i>	At or below \$1,133	At or below \$1,526
<i>125% poverty</i>	\$1,134 - \$1,416	\$1,527 - \$1,907
<i>150% poverty</i>	\$1,417 - \$1,699	\$1,908 - \$2,289
<i>175% poverty</i>	\$1,700 - \$1,982	\$2,290 - \$2,670
<i>200% poverty</i>	\$1,983 - \$2,265	\$2,671 - \$3,052
<i>Over 200% poverty</i>	\$2,266 or over	\$3,053 or over
